Powder for removing rust stains on natural stones

Description:

"MangiaRuggine" (“**RustEater**”) is a high quality, rust remover powder that, when mixed with water, removes rust from the surface of tile, masonry stones, pavers and natural stone. The dilution of the powder in water can vary to produce any desired consistency, depending upon the application: vertical or horizontal, large or small.

Instruction for Use:

1. Vertical Surfaces: Wet the surface with clean water. Using a terry cloth rag, apply the powder directly to the rag, and rub the rust stain with the rag to remove the stain. Flush with clean, warm water. Neutralize the surface with a neutral pH Simple S C’s MultiClean Stone Cleaner. Repeat the application if necessary.
2. Horizontal Surfaces: Wet the surface with clean water. Apply the powder directly on the stained surface. If preferred, dilute the powder with water in a small cup, mixing thoroughly and pour on the wet surface. Rub with a terry cloth rag or use a soft bristle brush and rub over the stain. If the stain is deeply embedded into the stone, let the solution stand on the surface for 5-15 minutes. Flush with clean, warm water. Neutralize the surface with a neutral pH Simple S C’s MultiClean Stone Cleaner. Repeat the application if necessary.
3. Large Concrete/Masonry/Stone Pavers: Wet the surface with clean water. Using a rotary machine with a solution tank, dilute one cup of MangiaRuggine Rust Powder in 1 Gallon of warm water. Saturate the area with the solution while scrubbing with the floor machine for 5-15 minutes. Flush with clean, warm water. Neutralize the surface with a neutral pH Simple S C’s MultiClean Stone Cleaner. Repeat the application if necessary.
4. **In order to prevent rust stains from reoccurring, apply either Simple S C’s Strong2000 or Simple S C’s Superseal. (See product instructions for proper applications)**

Suggestion for Use:

1. For resistant stains, repeat application.
2. Read the recommendations carefully as printed on label before use.
3. Product is mildly acidic. Not recommended for polished marble or other non-acid resistant surfaces.
4. **Always perform a test patch before use.**

Granites, terracotta, porphyry, cement, slate, concrete, ceramics, grès.
